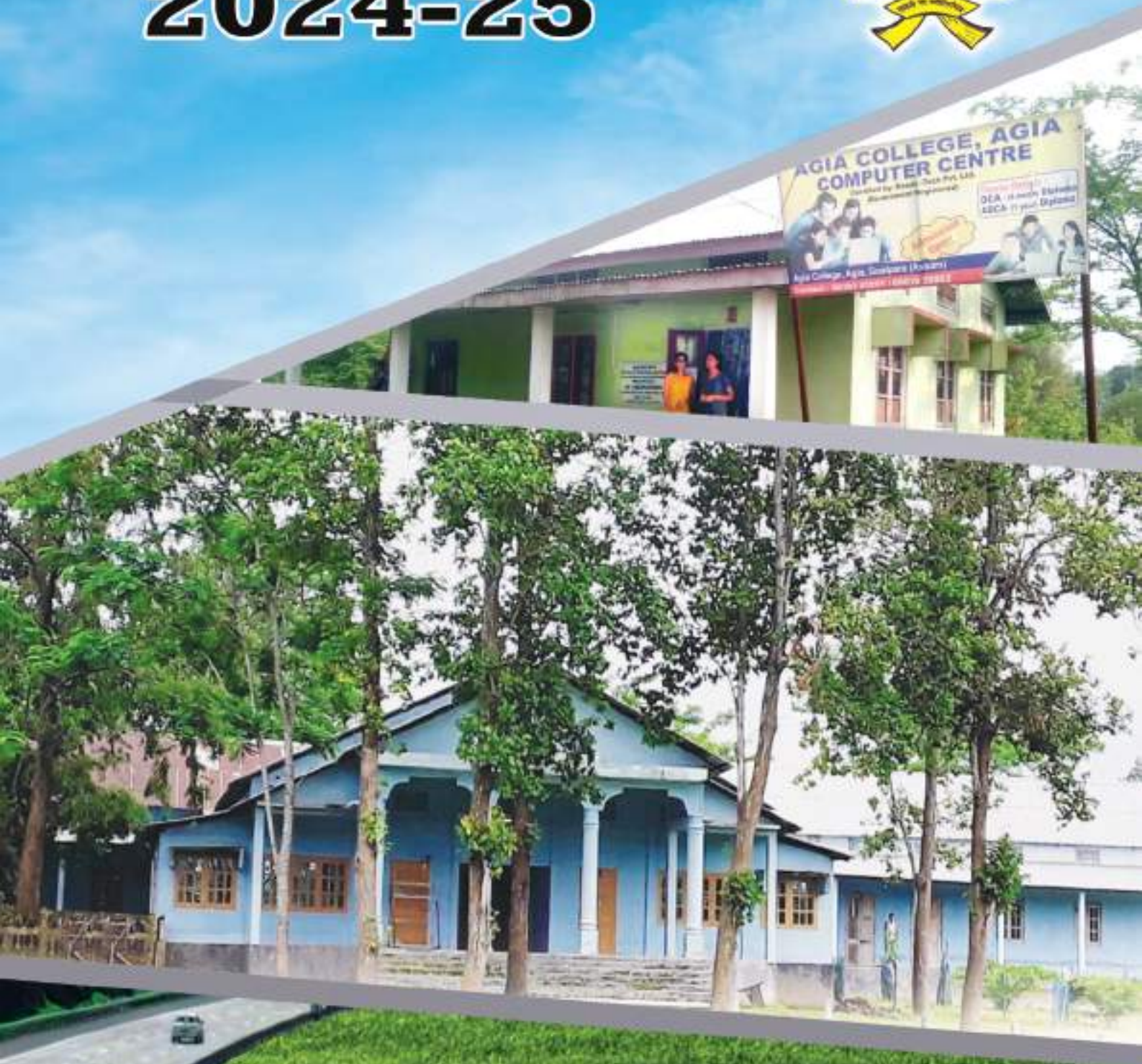

ABOUT THE COLLEGE

A) History of the College

On an auspicious occasion on 22nd day of August, 1996, the Agia College makes its existence temporarily at J. N. Memorial H.S. School building, Agia as a Degree Arts College under the Presidentship of Late Mahesh Ch. Nath, Secretaryship of Late Swahid Ray and Principalship of Late Dr. Monoj Kumar Chakraborty, with five lecturers and twenty nine students. Before its establishment the need for a Degree Arts College at Agia had for long been igniting the minds of the people here and also the remote neighbouring areas, as there were no college within a radius of 12 to 15 kms. the need for such higher Institution has been seriously felt.

Accordingly, the first meeting was held at Agia on 24th January, 1982 being chaired by Late Nibharsha Singha of Solmari Village and resolution taken unanimously on it. It was under the circumstances that a demand for setting up of Degree Arts College arose some years back to cater the needs of a large number of the aspiring youths along with the responsibilities of 10 (ten) Goan Panchayat areas with the population of about 1.25 Lakhs. A group of social worker, educationist of the locality viz. Late Kiran Ch. Nath, Late Bhabendra Narayan Ray, Sri Hemen Ray, Sri Sushil Kr. Roy, Sri Padma Bahadur Gurung, Sri Jaychandra Nath, Late Sirish Das, Sri Dhiraj Das, Sri Dhaneswar Das, Sri Dibya Lochan Das, Late Subhash Kalita, Late Nalini Bala Das, Smti Kanika Das, Late Dharani Das, Late Arabinda Das, Late Nripen Das, Sri Sushil Rabha, Sri Motilal Rabha, Sri Kiran Rabha, Sri Tapan Das and many other enthusiastic people were always in active participation to push forward and to fulfil the noble dream of the greater locality. Among them, Sri P.B. Gurung and Sri Sushil Kr. Roy had carried the pain of being the Secretary and President of the Managing Committee and Governing body accordingly.

Mr. Hareswar Sutradhar, M. A., B. T. (Retired Principal of J.N.M. H.S. School), Late Karuna Kanta Rabha, M.A. (Retired Principal of Dudhnoi College) and Late Rohit Kr. Sarma, M.A., M.Phil. (Retired Professor of Goalpara College) has shouldered the responsibility of the college as Principal till 31 July, 2005 accordingly after departure of Dr. Monoj Kr. Chakraborty.

However, the college is presently imparting education in its permanent building. The class room and other rooms are also arranged according to the guideline of the affiliating University.

The dream to build a permanent building came true with the upstream co-operation from the member of the sponsoring Body of the College, hard labour and whole-hearted will of the erstwhile Secretary Late Swahid Ray, a group of sympathetic and enthusiastic people of the locality, financial grants from MP and MLA funds, i.e. Sri Drupad Buragohain (Ex M.P. Rajya Sabha), Mr. Anowar Hussain (Ex. MP Dhubri Constituency), Sri. Jyotish Das and Sri Dulal Ch. Ghosh (Ex. MLA 37 Goalpara East Constituency respectively) along with local bodies like Kalyanpur Gaon Panchayat and Rabha Hasong Autonomous Council helped the college for stepping forward to achieve the goal. Besides the ceaseless effort and dignity of the past and present Managing Committee & Governing Body of the College accordingly are also noteworthy for progression of the college.

With the modest beginning in 1996, the college has already celebrated its Silver Jubilee year. The college has been emerging as a centre of quality education. Yet, it is felt that to meet the future challenges; the college must walk in planned root. Hopefully it is expected by proper implementation of future plans and programmes, the college will find a new vista in catering the challenges of modern education considering the needs of the region by introducing new vocational course. The first batch of student appeared B. A. final examination in the year 1999 and till last year a good number of students have passed B.A. from this college and rendering services in various fields.

B) Status of the College:

The College is permanently affiliated to Gauhati University and provincialised by the Govt. of Assam in the year 2021 w.e.f. 1st January. It is also registered under the Society Act. 1860.

C) Location of the College:

The College is situated on the southern part of the mighty river Brahmaputra and on east side of the National Highway No. 37 between Agia and Solmari in a very natural environment under 37 LAC. It is far from 10 (ten) Km's away from the district head quarter of Goalpara on the edge of "Urpada Bil", the picturesque of infinite beauty.

The GU-FYUGP (GU Four –year Undergraduate Programme) is a 4- year undergraduate degree programme aligned with NEP-2020.

Exits & Entries :

The GU-FYUGP supports multiple exits & entries. Each year, a student can exit the programme and can enter at a later time.

Degree, Diploma & Certificate :

On exit, a student gets a

Certificate at the end of the 1st year

Diploma at the end of the 2nd year

Bachelor's Degree with Major & Minors at the end of the 3rd year

Bachelor's Degree (Honourse) & Bachelor's Degree (Honours) with Research at the end of the 4th year

ADMISSION PROCEDURE

The Candidates who completed H.S. or equivalent examination have to register themselves in the SAMARTH Portal and choose Agia College for admission into FYUGP 1st Semester. College will publish the selection list on the basis of the applications and availability of seats. The selection list and admission date / dates will be declared in accordance with the guideline of Govt. of Assam. For all the dates candidates have to go through the Agia College website -

Eligibilites of the Candidate for Admission into FYUGP 1st Semester

1. Should passed H.S. or equivalent Examination from recognised Board / Council / University.
2. Gap should not exceed 5 (five) years i.e. should be completed H.S. or equivalent Examination on or after 2019.

Salient features of FYUGP (NEP-2020) :

(i) Though, the FYUGP is built on the CBCS. It is radically different from the courses running under CBCS. It does not differentiate between so-called Honours and Pass Courses existing under CBCS. Unlike CBCS the NEP's FYUGP is a Four Year Degree Programme.

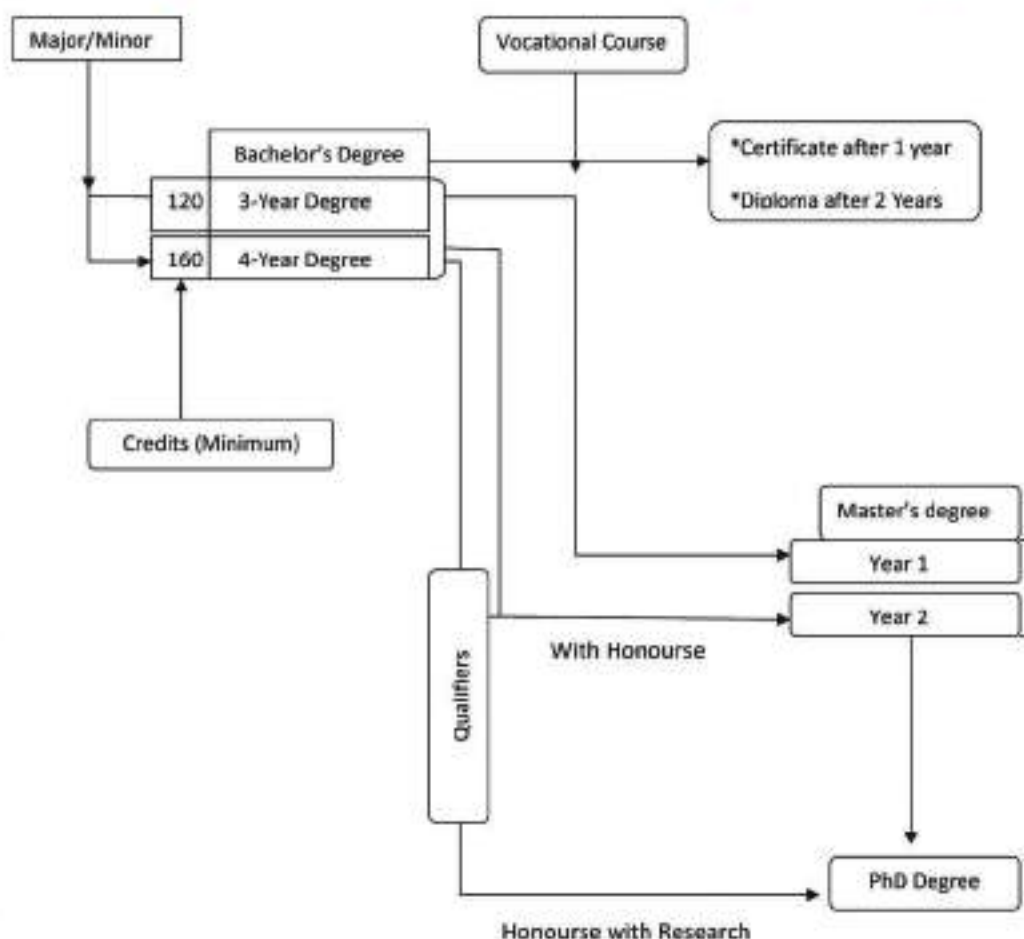
(ii) Multiple Exit and Entries : In FYUGP a student can exit after any year. Depending on the exit level, a student can get a Certificate, a Diploma or Degree. If a student exits after one year into the programme, he/she will get a certificate. Similarly, he/she will get a Diploma if exits after two years into the programme and eventually, after three years he/she will get a Bachelor's Degree.

N.B: Every students who wants to exit before three years into the programme, Must complete an additional Vocational Course of four credits.

(iii) After the completion of third year one can advance to the fourth year. After successful completion of the fourth year, he/she gets either a Bachelor's Degree (Honours with Research).

(iv) A student will have a span of seven years to complete FYUGP (NEP-2020). Where he/she can exit and enter into the courses maximum for three times—after the completion of first year, after the completion of second year and after completion of third year.

Progression under GU-FYUGP (NEP 2020) :

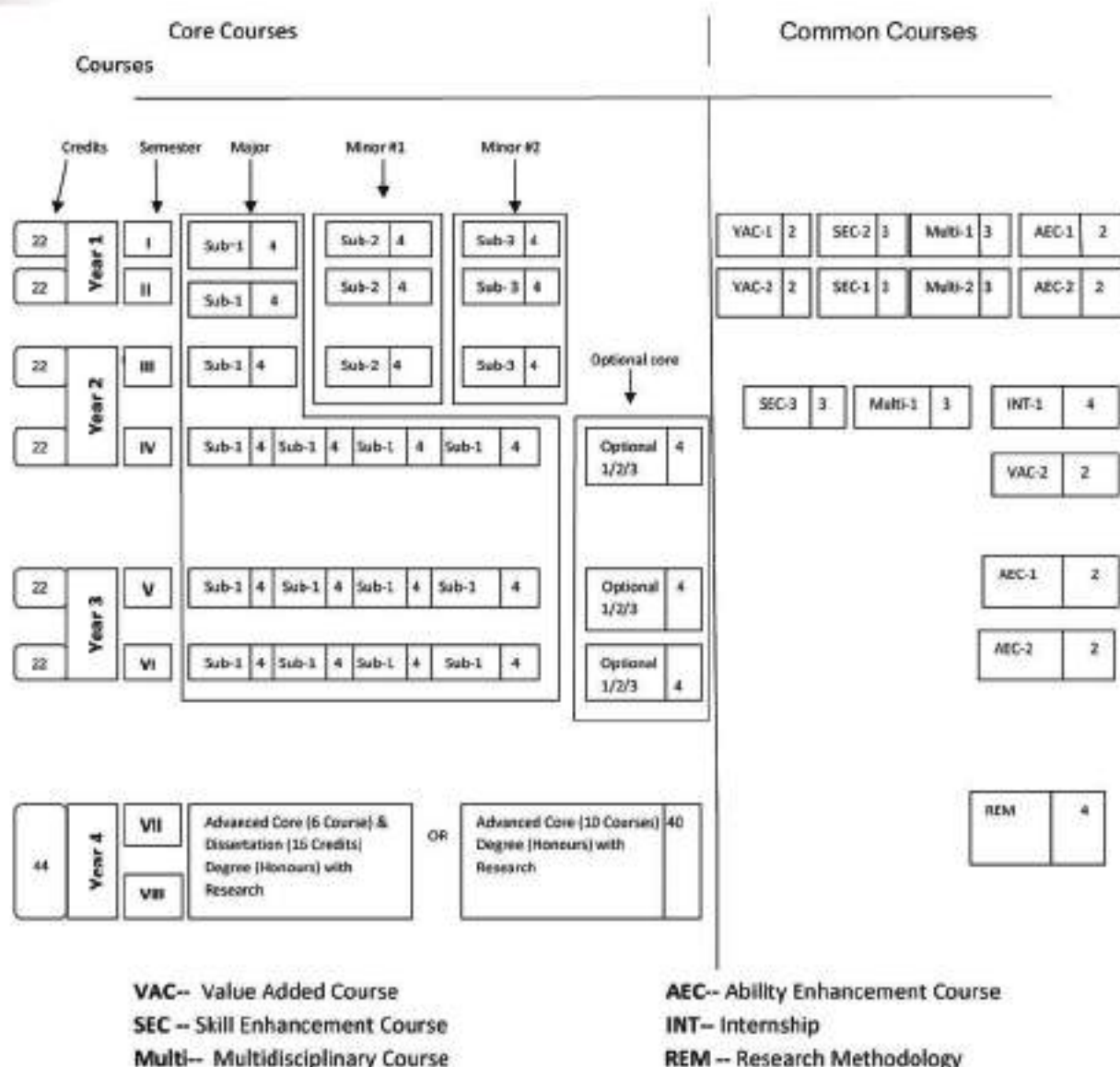


FYUGP Course structure :

There are two parts of a course under the FYUGP- (a) Core Courses and (b) Common Courses. Which means different students study different core courses and all students study Common Courses. To simplify it we can say, one studies three different core subjects in First Year(Semester 1 and 2)- one of each per semester. Besides, one needs to study a host of common subject as designed as per UGC's Curricular Framework. Likewise courses are divided in several combinations in 2nd ,3rd and 4th year. However, if one intends to progress to the 4th year he/she will have to study advanced courses and Research Work. In FYUGP (NEP-2020) one obtain double major also in exchange of some extra online courses.

CREDIT AND ATTENDANCE:

All classes that a student attends are ultimately converted to academic credits. The following should be noted

- (a) The allotment of a credit for certain course (i.e. paper) is for the duration of a Semester.
- (b) In GU-FYUGHP, all credits are calculated on a weekly-basis and one week is a span of days from Monday to the next Sunday. The conversion from credit to contact hour of teaching is as follows:
 1 Credit = 1 Hour of Theory Class OR
 1 Credit = 2 Hours of Practical Class
- (c) The 'Theory Class' can be any of (i) A teaching Class in a Classroom, (i) A tutorial Class, or (ii) Assignments.
- (d) The 'Practical Class' can be either (i) A Practical Class Conducted in a Laboratory or (ii) A Project Work.

CONVERSION TO CLASS HOURS:

It is expected that in the course of a Semester, a minimum of 11 (eleven) weeks of classes should be conducted. So, a 4-credit theory course should have a minimum of 44 hours of teaching in a Semester, which roughly translates to 44 one-hour theory classes. The following examples explain this conversion in details for a whole Semester.

(a) A course with 4 Theory Credits

$$4 \times 11 = 44 \text{ Hours of Teaching}$$

(b) A course with 3 Theory and 1 Practical Credits

$$3 \times 11 + 1 \times 22 = 55 \text{ Hours of Teaching}$$

(c) A Course with 2 Theory and 2 Practical Credits

$$2 \times 11 + 2 \times 22 = 66 \text{ Hours of Teaching}$$

(d) A course with 4 Practical Credits

$$4 \times 22 = 88 \text{ Hours of Teaching}$$

N.B.: Attendance is compulsory for all students in their respective courses.

FACILITIES OFFERED BY AGIA COLLEGE

Software based Library:

The college provides software based library and reading room facilities to the students as well as for the teachers with good quantity of books. In addition to the books supporting to the syllabus of each semesters, periodicals, Journals and News Papers are regularly subscribed in the college library. The students can borrow books from the library through his/her library Membership Card. For library membership card, an application to the librarian should be submitted in the prescribed format obtainable from the college library. All members have to follow the rules and regulations of the college library in all respect relating to the College Library. Borrowers must return the books within the given period and are personally responsible for the loss and damage of any book borrowed.

Students' Aid Fund :

This fund is kept to help the economically poor students on the basis of merit, attendance and regular observation subject to the availability of fund. Needy student are to apply to the Principal, enclosing necessary certificates from the competent authority and following necessary procedure framed for this purpose. The settlement is subject to the satisfaction of the college authority.

Common Room :

Separate Common Room facilities for both Boys' and Girls' are available including necessary accommodation and time consuming units.

NSS Unit :

Interested students may join in the National Service Scheme (NSS) Unit which will provide them not only the opportunities to render social services both inside and outside the college but also to develop personality under the guidance of a trained NSS Programme officer. The students may build themselves with the motto NOT ME BUT YOU.

Sports and Gymnasium :

The college provides sports and gymnasium facilities for physical training of the students to keep their body and mind fresh.

Career Guidance and Counselling Cell :

A career Guidance and Counselling Cell is run by the college for providing necessary guidance & information to the students under the leadership of an experienced coordinator appointed by the college authority.

Classroom with Audio-Visual Aids:

Facility of classroom with audio-visual aids like over-head projector, various kinds of practical apparatuses, charts, maps etc. are used for wholesome understanding and firsthand experience of the students.

Govt. Scholarship :

The College is enlisted in the Govt. Scholarship Portal for Scholarship and students of the college belong to Schedule Caste, Schedule Tribe (P) & (H), Other Backward Classes, More Other Backward Classes and Minority are awarded Post Matric Scholarship by concerned Govt. authority on the basis of their application. Students will get the scholarship to their submitted account directly from the Govt. concerned department.

Students can avail Free Admission Scholarship as per Fee Waiver Scheme offered by Govt. of Assam subject to fulfilment of the conditions.

Special Felicitation:

The student accorded the highest mark among the students of Agia College appeared in the B. A. Final examination without having any arrear/back in any semester will be felicitated every year in the general meeting held for celebration of the Foundation Day of the college.

Students Union and Activities:

The Agia College Students' Union is the general body of the students of this college. Its membership is compulsory for every regular student admitted in the college. The Office bearers of the union are democratically elected for tenure of one year by the regular members. For all round development of the students, the Students' Union Body organizes various co-curricular and extra-curricular activities and competitions with the active guidance of teacher in-charge and the interested students may participate in such activities. The members of the Student Union have to wear the uniform specially designed for.

Workshops and Seminars :

Workshops and Seminars are organised time to time by different departments and other prestigious organisations to uphold the intellectual and reasoning capabilities of the students.

Field Trip and Excursions:

Agia College regularly organises Field Trip and Excursions for the all round development of the students. Apart from this, students are encouraged as well as taken to different organisations to take part different competitions.

GENERAL RULES AND REGULATIONS

COLLEGE UNIFORM:

The students should wear the prescribed college uniform inside the college campus. No student is allowed to attend the classes without the prescribed uniform. The colour code of the uniform for boys are black long pant, light yellow shirt in summer and with black sweater in winter. Like, for girls black Pant (payjama), light yellow Kamij (should cover shoulder to knee), black Dopatta/Worm for summer and with black sweater in winter. It is for special attention that **Jacket, Summer Coat, Scarp, leggings are not allowed to wear as college uniform.**

N.B. : It is compulsory to wear uniform during the examination period.

IDENTITY CARD

A non transferable Identity Card is issued to each student in every session for a period of one year containing relevant information of the card holder together with a recent stamp size photograph. The Identity is issued on the basis of realization of Data from the student online submitted admission form (auto generated). Students must carry valid Identity Card in the College campus.

MAINTENANCE OF DISCIPLINE

In matters of healthy practices, the college gives high priority to adhere the rules and regulations of the college for maintenance of discipline in the college campus. Every student is expected to abide by these rules and regulations. The following rules have been framed in this direction :

(i) Use of mobile or cellphones inside the Academic Block by students is strictly prohibited.

(ii) Ragging is human rights abuse in a essence. All forms of ragging in college campus are prohibited. Strong disciplinary action will be taken if any student is found to be involved directly or indirectly in ragging. As per recommendation of the R.K. Raghavan Committee, the following punishments will be imposed if any students is found to be indulged or provoking ragging in the college campus.

- a) Suspension from attending the class
- b) Rustication from the college
- c) Expulsion from the college.

(iii) Students must not loiter in the corridors so as to disturb other classes. The college authority may take strong action for this regard.

(iv) Students must maintain silence and discipline in the reading room of the library. In no way they should indulge gossiping and nonacademic activities. Violation of this norms may lead to cancellation of library membership.

(v) Students must follow uniform dress code during college hours.

(vi) Students must carry valid Identity Cards in the college days.

(vii) Consumption of Gutka, Panmasala or any other intoxicants in the college campus is strictly prohibited.

(viii) Students shall park their own bicycle, bike, car etc. at their own risks.
